

PUBLIC GIFTS TO THE DISTRICT

The District shall encourage and welcome gifts from organizations and individuals when they will improve District programs, operations, or facilities. However, the cost of obtaining, installing, maintaining, and protecting any gift must be less than the value of the gift. Moreover, neither the sources nor the uses of such gifts shall be objectionable to a significant number of community residents, District personnel, or students.

The District may seek and accept gifts from organizations and from individuals to improve their programs, operations, or facilities.

All gifts shall be acknowledged and recorded. Public recognition may be given for major gifts.
