



My name makes people feel nice about me.



People call me Mani, Mama, Amari and Armani.





My name brings happiness and fun.



My name is not Ja'mair.


My name sounds like Mimir, dogs, clarinets.

People call me Jayla, Baila, Pigs and Piglet.


My name sounds like the shore and bay.

Unfortunately we had our own life. Now I was 17 when we finally found mom. It looked like monkeys attacked her.


Then a helicopter came and saw us. We were relieved. We moved to Florida and were finally home!

My name is Kobeigh.



My name makes my mom feel happy and funny.




