Goal Setting and Growth Mindset

Goal Setting for CMRS K8 Scholars

Our school is helping our kids understand the skill of setting goals and following through on them. This month at our PAC meeting, the school will be presenting information to parents and caregivers about how to help our kids set goals and how to help them achieve their goals.

I want to share a goals chart with you guys so you can start helping your scholars at home with their academic goals. This is just a simple organizer to help your scholar set a goal that they can achieve and come up with a realistic timeline for achieving that goal. You want them to be specific about their goal and think about an action. What will they do?Improve their grades, work harder, attend classes more frequently? Have them think about an action to do. A measurable goal means that it can easily be tracked. If the goal is about their school work, then you and your scholar can track their completion rate by checking Schoology daily. You can measure and track an attendance goal by placing a star sticker on a calendar for each day that they attend class. Achievable goals can be ambitious but they must be possible. This about your child's strengths and weaknesses and plan accordingly. This ties into the goal being realistic. We all have a capacity for what we can achieve, think about your child and their grade level. Help them set goals that are appropriate for their age and knowledge. A timed goal means that there is a deadline. If your scholar wants better grades in quarter 3 then the deadline is the last day of the third marking period. I hope that this chart helps when you are supporting your scholar at home.

Growth Mindset in Kids

What is the growth mindset and how can it help our scholars achieve more in school? A growth mindset helps us change how we see our own potential. It allows us to see that our abilities can improve through working hard and being strategic. To cultivate this mindset in our kids we have to let them know that making mistakes is part of the process and that it is okay to embrace your mistakes and learn from them. Encourage your kids to be resilient, bend but don't break but if you do break, you can always bounce back. Help your child find their passions and embrace their creative mind. Praise the process and the hard work and

being okay with failure because they can learn from it. Set high expectations for your child and help them love the learning process. Always motivate them and praise their efforts.
