Ohio's State Tests 2024

The testing window for OST's is opening this month. Students in grades 3-8 will be taking these assessments. All students will take reading and mathematics assessments. Students in grades 5 and 8 will take science assessments as well. The reading assessment is especially important for kids in grade 3 because of the state's <u>Third Grade Reading Guarantee</u>.

While these assessments are important, I don't believe that students and parents should stress over them. They are not an indicator of your child's intelligence and even if they don't do well, it doesn't mean that your child is not a good student or won't succeed in school. Teachers at our school have been preparing scholars everyday for these tests. The work and assignments that our kids complete help prepare them for every test that is delivered to them. One of the most important things we can do to ensure our scholars succeed is making sure that they attend school everyday and complete all of their work. The assignments that teachers create are guided by some of things that kids will see on the tests. When kids complete iXL assignments, that prepares them for the OST's. When scholars in grades 3 and 4, work and read in Amira then they are prepping for the test. When students complete their assignments in Writable, then they are prepping for the tests. Keeping scholars engaged in their work everyday is what really prepares them for these tests. Help and motivate your child to complete their assignments.

Again, don't stress, just prepare your child. On the day of the test, make sure they eat a nice breakfast. Reassure them that this assessment is not the most important thing they will achieve in school. Let them know that they are ready and give them some tools to use to stay relaxed and focused during the test. Read this article here about testing anxiety and how to cope through it.
