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High School Poverty


Poverty effects kids not just parents. When parents go through poverty, their children do to because their parents doesnt have enough money to get them new things.

Findings: Observation

Findings: Survey

- We surveyed 22 high school students.
- 10% say they don't have enough clothes for school
- 10% say they don't have enough school shoes
- 10% say they are in lower economic class
- 10% say they eat once or twice a day
