


Welcome Back!

learning more about what to expect for the school year. It's a look at what our school community does and what it's like to be a part of our school community.




Attendance Counts!

September is Attendance Awareness Month

Attendance is important to a scholar's academic success. Attending class each day ensures that a student is learning what they should learn.

At the Remote School, students should attend class daily. Monday through Friday from 8 am to 2:30 pm. Our asynchronous day is Monday and Tuesday-Friday are live class days. Asynchronous days are not off days, but independent work days. Students attend the morning meeting and complete assignments.

Attendance is taken by the hour not the day. Meaning that any minutes or hours a child is tardy or not in class, it counts towards their attendance and the time adds up. If a child misses 30 minutes a day of school, then that adds up to 2 and half hours of school. An hour a day is 5 hours missed.
