For the United States the official poverty rate is 12.7 percent. In 2013 43.1 million Americans lived in poverty and the rate was 14 percent, 13.5 million people reported to be in deep poverty. This meant that the household income had to be below 50 percent of their 2016 poverty threshold, 5.8 percent of all americans and 45.6 percent of those in poverty. The official rate of poverty of the United States ranged somewhere around 22.4 percent. The poverty line was \$1.90 a day. Essentially the poverty rates have changed dramatically from 2013 to 2016.
