# Summary

The following spreadsheet shows the revenue and expenditures by month for the General Funds as of February 29, 2020. The total revenues forecasted in the October five year forecast were \$744,012,511 and expenditures were \$761,760,050. The adopted budget approved by the Board was \$761,760,050 plus carryover encumbrances of \$17,598,133 for a total appropriation of \$779,358,183.

## **Revenue Summary**

The Cleveland Metropolitan School District is forecasting \$744,012,511 in revenue within the General Fund for the 2020 fiscal year as shown on Figure 1. As of February 29, 2020 the District has received revenue in the amount of \$559,812,666. The District will need to collect another \$184,199,845 to reach its target.

#### Notes

- (a) The District received \$204,844,499 in general property taxes in FY19 and is forecasted \$192,578,338 in FY20. As of February 29, 2020 the District has received \$195,685,048.
- (b) The District will receive state funding in FY20 based on HB 305.




Figure 2: Revenue by Category

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Figure 2 below compares revenue sources to the prior two years as of February. The three years of data will be beneficial for trend analysis performed throughout the year.

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### **Expenditure Summary**

The fiscal year 2020 General Fund budget for the District is \$761,760,050. This budget, coupled with carryover encumbrances of \$17,598,133, resulted in a \$779,358,183 appropriation for FY 2020. The following information is a financial update of the status of this appropriation through February 29, 2020.




Figure 3: Expenditure Level Through February

Through February 29, 2020 the District has expended \$502,348,764 which reflects 64.00% of the District's total appropriation (see Exhibit A). The District also has outstanding encumbrances of \$. A statistical spending range for the District is based on two analyses: first, time elapsed is eight months, or 66.67%, of the fiscal year. Secondly, 34 of the 51, or 66.67%, of the total pay periods have passed. Figure 3 illustrates these points.

Overall, the District's expenditure level through February is trending slightly below target based on the above analysis. As an examination of the categories of expenditures is performed, cyclical variances are noted between categories which related specifically to school opening activities.




Figure 4: % Spend to Budget for YTD Expenditures




Figure 5: Expenditure by Category

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Figure 4 compares the various expenditure categories to the expected level and to the prior two years. Figure 5 provides the year to date expenditure level by category for the current year as well as the prior two. The three years of data will be beneficial for trend analysis performed throughout the year. Further discussion of these two figures is included on the following page.

Target percent of 66.67% is based on the # of months completed in the current year.

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As Figures 4 and 5 illustrate, overall salaries and fringe benefits are less than prior years. This is due to the timing of payroll periods and we expect this to flatten out as the year goes on. The trend line in Figure 4 is based on the time elapsed for the year. Health care costs are forecasted to increase 7.5% in FY 20 from FY 19.

The current year Purchased Services and Materials categories indicate a 70.70% encumbrance/expenditure level for this month.

The Capital encumbrance/expenditure level, whose budget comprises only .6% of the total General Fund budget, indicates a 56.10% encumbrance/expenditure level for this month. It should be noted that the vast majority of on-going construction projects are accounted for in other funds and therefore not reflected in the encumbrances/expenditures above.

Finally, the debt service and other objects category of encumbrance/expenditures, which mainly reflects the payment of treasurer and auditor fees, and the transfer of monies to other District funds (as required by State regulations), is as expected as of February 29, 2020. Debt payments occur in July and April while the transfer of monies to other District funds will occur in June.


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#### **Cash Balances**
